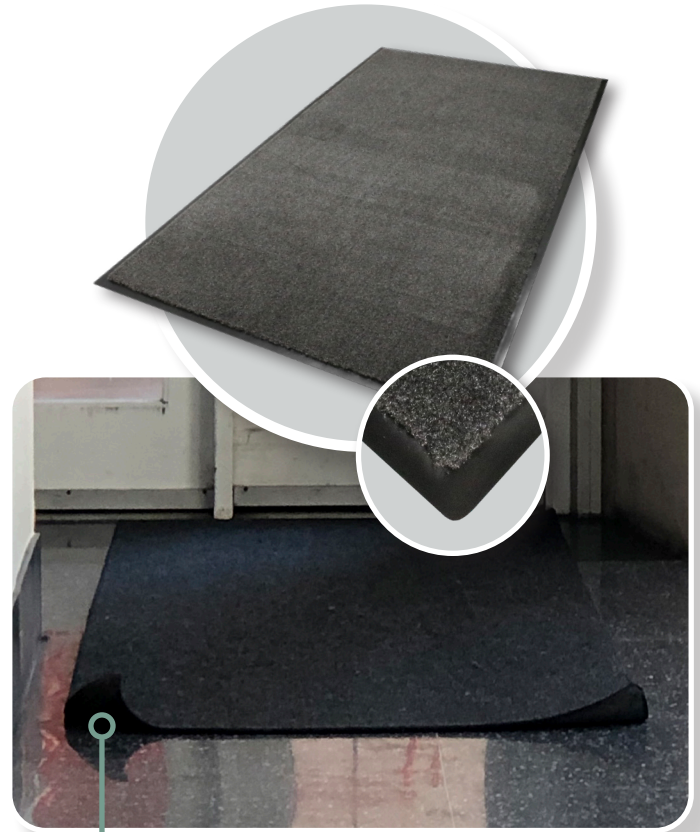
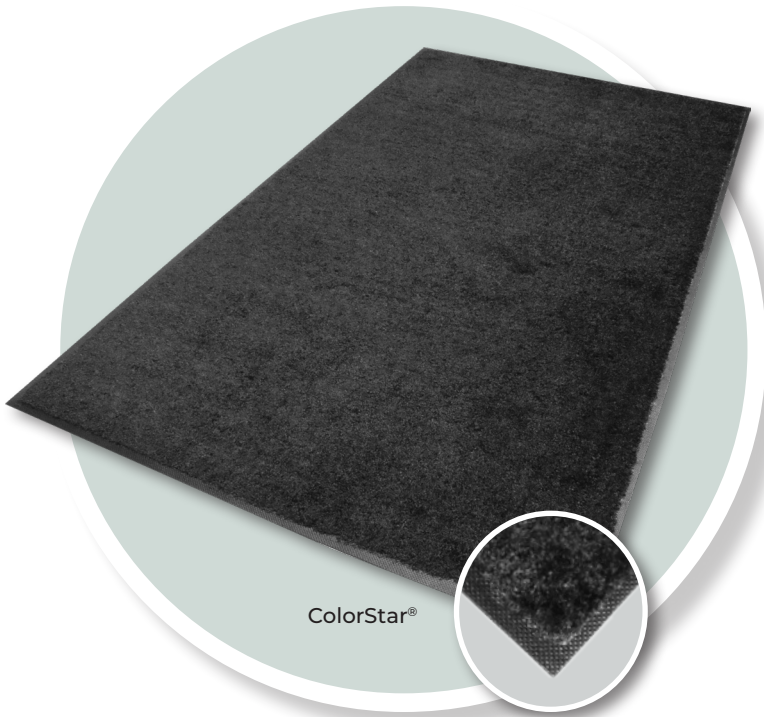

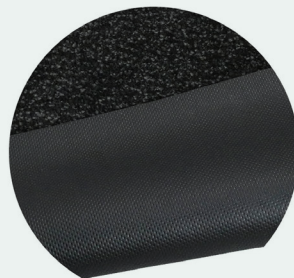


COST OF OWNERSHIP

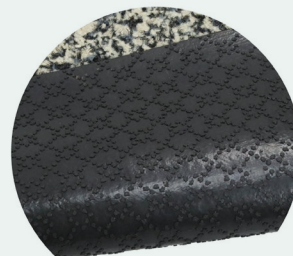
Vinyl is traditionally less expensive than rubber but has a shorter life expectancy. Rubber mats are incredibly durable with a much longer life expectancy, meaning they do not have to be replaced as often, lowering your total cost of ownership.

Vinyl mats are **prone to cracking and curling** around the edges.

M+A Matting's Rubber Backing Types

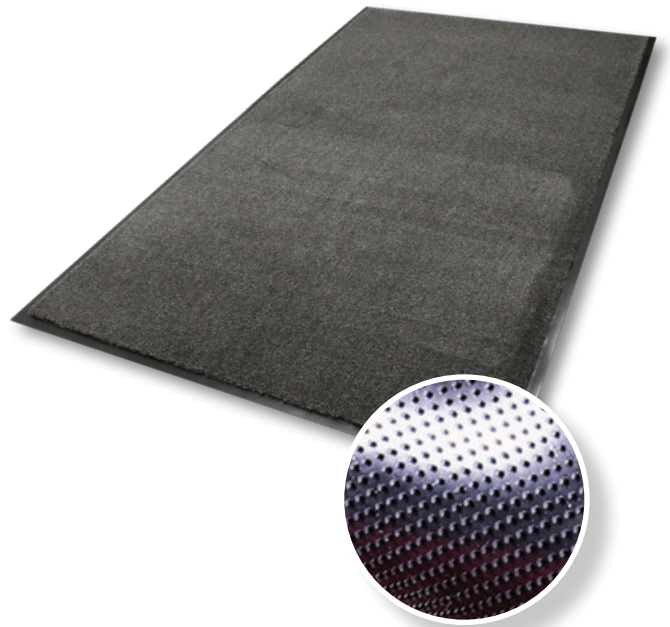


Smooth Backing
